- Commitment and responsibility to lead team and achieve personal and team work goals in a timely and safe manner. First Aid certification a plus.
- Proven leadership experience, including ability to communicate, address personnel issues, and make fair decisions related to project demands, customer service, and employee assignments.

### **Fire Sprinkler Fitter - Basic Job Responsibilities:**

- Complete the lay out, fabrication, installation, repair, and maintenance of fixed fire protection systems, in accordance with manufacturer instructions, related codes/standards, and Company policies/procedures.
- Interpret blueprints and/or working drawings in order to properly install, repair, and maintain systems.
- Cut, thread, and groove pipe using proper tools and machines. Join and secure pipe using proper standards and techniques. Ensure that job sites are left clean and neat.
- Verify and/or select the proper materials for a specific job according to job specifications. Track and communicate material needs in a timely manner.
- Plan sequence of installation or repair to ensure that customer's activities are not obstructed or adversely affected.
- Identify changes to proposed work and communicate changes with Foreman.

- Install, operate, maintain, troubleshoot, and repair all aspects of Fire Sprinkler Systems.
- General knowledge in the construction field with a high willingness to learn.
- Experience is preferred.
